WEEKEND MEAL PROGRAM

Darien Human Services participates in a partnership with *Filling in the Blanks* weekend meal program. *Filling in the Blanks* is a local non-profit organization that provides food on the weekends to school aged children (www.fillingintheblanks.org). Each packet consists of a variety of nonperishable food items such as oatmeal, granola bars, fruit cups, mac and cheese, canned food, tuna and chips. Meal packets are distributed bi-weekly at Town Hall during designated times to families who struggle with food insecurity.
