
Here are some eco-friendly tips for a more sustainable holiday

- **Gift Wrapping:** Traditional wrapping paper typically can't be recycled. Get creative and use old newspaper or fabric scraps. Or opt for brown craft paper, which can be recycled or reused.
- **Candles:** Use environmentally sustainable candles. Beeswax, soy, and palm oil provide more natural alternatives to traditional paraffin candles.


