2022-2023 DARIEN SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET PROCESS UPDATE

On Tuesday, January 11th, the Board of Education held a meeting; the full recording can be found <u>here</u>. Discussion regarding the proposed Darien Public School District budget for 2022-2023 begins at 1:45. Public comment takes place at the very beginning and the very end of the meeting.

In order to ensure that ALL voices are heard, we want to hear input from parents in the Royle community. Thanks to those who have given feedback so far, as well as our meetings with Dr. Mullin, below are some key topics we have identified:
